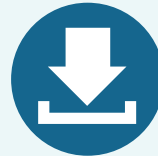

Install the eduroam CAT configuration utility

- Point your browser to **cat.eduroam.org**



- Select your home institution and download the software.



- Once the download is finished, click on the installer.



- Go through the steps and enter the username and password for the account you have through your institution. Done!
